MATERIALS

Personal Information Form: Please fill in all questions.

Statement of Research: Briefly describe the focus of your research and your research agenda for the next 2-5 years. The statement should be no more than 1 page, using 11- or 12-point font.

Curriculum Vitae: The curriculum vitae should include the following sections – name and mailing address, education with degree and dates of completion, paid employment, honors and awards (including grant awards), professional affiliations and licensures, research and evaluation experience, teaching experience, publications, presentations at conferences, and continuing education.

Writing Sample: This is an optional item. The submission should be a scholarly, journal length manuscript that the applicant was the major contributor (first author).
